#### **DIGITAL SINGLE MARKET**

The Digital Single Market strategy aims to open up digital opportunities for people and business and enhance Europe's position as a world leader in the digital economy.

- > April 2018 Communication on a Common European data space
- Proposed update of Directive on the Reuse of Public Sector
  Information
- ➤ April 2018 Recommendation on access to and preservation of Scientific Information
- ➤ April 2018 Staff Working Document Guidance on sharing private sector data in the European data economy
